

# Field Trip Car Parking and Public Transportation

## Know Before You Go

- Distribute wristbands before coming to the zoo, so your group arrives with these on and ready to go.
- Ensure your group has the lead teacher's contact information in case they need to contact them.
- Once your entire group has arrived, report to front entry.

## Car Parking

Hourly Parking: \$2.00

All Day Parking: \$8.00

Parking is paid at pay stations inside Washington Park or through the Parking Kitty app at [parkingkitty.com](http://parkingkitty.com)

Coins and credit cards are accepted at pay stations.

## Public Transportation

MAX Blue Line – Hillsboro/City Center/Gresham

MAX Red Line – Airport/City Center/Beaverton

MAX service arrives frequently to the Washington Park/Oregon Zoo tunnel station, with trains running until midnight.

MAX tunnel west elevator opens just across from the entrance to the Oregon Zoo.

One-way MAX tickets are \$2.50 for adults and \$1.50 for youth and honored citizens.
